

Volunteer Code of Conduct

RESIDENT INTERACTION:

- 1. At no time may a volunteer be alone with a single child where volunteer cannot be observed by others.
- 2. Volunteers may never leave a child unsupervised.
- 3. Volunteers shall not abuse children or use corporal punishment of any kind. This includes physical, verbal, mental abuse or neglect.
- 4. Volunteers will respect a child's right to not be touched in ways that make them feel uncomfortable.
- 5. Volunteers will only use "appropriate" touch, including pats on the back or shoulder, side hugs, handshakes and high fives with children.
- 6. Volunteers will not give gifts or special favors to individual residents or show preferential treatment.
- 7. Volunteers will not have private interactions through social media, computer or hand held devices with any resident in the program.
- 8. Volunteers will treat all residents equally without regard to gender, race, religion, sexual identity or culture.
- 9. Volunteers will not pressure residents to participate in religious activities, including religious music, worship, prayer and religious-focused teachings.

RESPONSIBILITIES WHILE VOLUNTEERING:

- 1. Using or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- 2. Smoking or use of tobacco products is prohibited.
- 3. Profanity, inappropriate jokes, sharing details of one's personal life is prohibited.
- 4. Be on time. If you are unable to serve, please notify Volunteer Coordinator as far in advance as possible.
- 5. Leave valuables at home or locked in car out of sight.
- 6. Dress casually but conservatively.
- 7. Sign in at the front desk.
